# Champaner

WORLD HERITAGE SITE - near Vadodara



Champaner - Pavagadh Archaeological Park is a UNESCO World Heritage Site near Baroda. It was inscribed in 2004.

There is a concentration of largely unexcavated archaeological, historic and living cultural heritage properties cradled in an impressive landscape which includes prehistoric (chalcolithic) sites, a hill fortress of an early Hindu capital, and remains of the 16th century capital of the state of Gujarat. The site also includes, among other vestiges, fortifications, palaces, religious buildings, residential precincts, agricultural structures and water installations, from the 8th to the 14th centuries.
